### Water Main Flushing

Groton Utilities will continue its annual water main flushing and cleaning program Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> to June 19<sup>th</sup>. The program is scheduled to be completed on June 19<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.

**Due to the size of the water main, all Groton Utilities customers should expect intermittent intervals of water discoloration during the May and June water main flushing process.**

Groton Utilities will clean water mains between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., following the schedule below.

There will be no evening flushing.

**Hydrant flushing schedule for the week of June 15<sup>th</sup> – June 19<sup>th</sup>:**

- North Road, Route 117 to Ledyard and along Route 184
- North Section of the City from Poquonnock Road to Bridge Street
- Dolphin Gardens, including all side streets.

At various times during the cleaning, the water will be discolored due to the disturbance of naturally occurring minerals that have settled in the water mains.

The water is safe to drink. However, because of discoloration, Groton Utilities advises customers to store tap water in the refrigerator for drinking and cooking until the water clears up. Residents should also check the condition of the water prior to washing clothes. If the water is discolored, delay doing laundry until the water is clear.
